STRATEGIC RESOURCE PLAN 2018 - 2022

Executive Summary

In accordance with section 125 (7) of the Local Government Act (the Act) council is obligated to, at least once in every financial year review the Council Plan which also incorporates the Strategic Resource Plan (SRP).

A review of the SRP identified material changes largely as a result of

- confirmation of the first year annual rate cap
- amendments contained in the Rates and Service Charges Strategy
- amendments to the timing of major projects within the previous SRP's timelines.

The updated SRP was provided for community feedback during May and no submissions were received.

The Strategic Resource Plan 2018-2022 is attached for Council consideration and once adopted the SRP will be incorporated into the 2017 – 2021 Council Plan.

MOIRA SHIRE COUNCIL BUDGET 2018/19

Executive Summary

This report seeks Council's approval of the Moira Shire Council Budget 2018/19.

The budget has been amended in response to feedback received during the community consultation period that included feedback at eight councillor-lead community drop in sessions along with more than 30 submissions from members of the community.

The budget delivers a balanced budget within a constrained fiscal environment. The capital component of the budget has been developed through the council's investment evaluation methodology to ensure that asset renewal and risk management drive investment priorities.

The 2018/19 budget commits council to delivering its largest ever capital works program with a total of \$21.107 million of works funded through a combination of state and federal grants, rates, user contributions and \$2.8 million drawn from council's reserves.

The capital works comprise \$8.8 million of new projects, \$2.8 million of upgrades to existing infrastructure and \$9.5 million of renewals to repair and maintain existing buildings, facilities roads and other infrastructure.
