As work has now commenced on the Yarrawonga Library project, please note the following changes as part of the traffic management plan:

- 40km speed limits on Hume and Orr streets
- There is now temporary fencing around car parks on Orr Street
- There will be temporary fencing along Hume Street in the near future reducing the width of the road

The road works are expected to last approximately 15 months, subject to weather conditions.
