Flood and Disaster Recovery Survey

Council are undertaking a community survey around the October 2022 Flood Event. This survey is targeted at Moira Shire residents who were impacted by this event. The results of the survey will help Council to understand how



prepared the community is for flood events. what are we doing well currently, what results are we getting, where are we seeing success and what we can do better.

These results will be used to guide future disaster recovery planning,

analyse current flood and disaster recovery methods, establish baseline metrics and assess competency of utilised practices. A further survey will be conducted in 2024.
