
Kerbside Collection Changes -Be part of the conversation

Animal Renewal Notices

Notices to register pets should arrive in your mail soon. Legislation requires that all dogs and cats 3 months of age and over must be microchipped and registered with Council. To register your pet, either follow the instructions within your notice or visit our website. Pet registrations must be renewed by **Wednesday 10 April 2024.**

Lump Sum Rate Payment Extension

Council wishes to inform residents that the deadline for lump sum rate payments has been **extended until 31 March** for those who have not yet received their reminder notices. Unfortunately, continued technical issues have led to further delays in the dispatch of reminder notices. We appreciate the community's patience and apologies for any inconvenience caused.

Flood Recovery Grants

The Community Flood Recovery and Resilience Grants offer up to \$5,000 to eligible not-for-profit organisations or groups impacted by the October 2022 Flood Event.
