

Soft plastics recycling, it's time to start collecting!

Moir Shire Council are partnering with Recyclesmart to provide our community a soft plastics recycling solution, with drop-off points opening in July, to help you reduce what goes in your landfill bin.

Soft plastic are plastics that can be easily scrunched in your hand. Things like bubble wrap, chip packets, post satchels, bread bags, zip lock bags and frozen produce bags.

Before you recycle:

- ✔ Have you removed labels, staples, etc?
- ✔ Is it dry?
- ✔ Is it relatively clean?

Things that are not soft plastic:

- ✘ Biodegradable and compostable plastics
- ✘ Drinking straws
- ✘ Rigid plastic containers – such as biscuit trays
- ✘ Laminated materials

Drop off points will be located at our Resource Recovery Centres in Cobram, Nathalia, Numurkah and Yarrowonga. For more information and to find out what happens to collected soft plastics, head to our website.

Mr John Tanner AM will conclude his role as Chair of the Panel of Administrators at Moira Shire Council on **Sunday 9 June**, with Graeme Emonson PSM acting as Chair during Mr Tanner's leave from Wednesday 5 June 2024.

During his tenure Mr Tanner focused on governance, transparency, and community engagement.

Key achievements include the appointment of CEO Matthew Morgan for stability and reviews on major project delivery for the likes of the Yarrowonga Library, Events and Performance Precinct, the Numurkah Levee, the Yarrowonga Multisport Stadium.

Administrators Graeme Emonson PSM and Suzanna Sheed AM will continue their roles until October 2028.

Mr Tanner expressed pride in the council's progress and optimism for its future ahead of the return to an elected council in 2028.
