### Numurkah Agricultural Show Public Holiday Declared

The Minister for Small Business, the Hon Natalie Suleyman MP, has approved the request to declare a public holiday for the Numurkah Agricultural Show. This was gazetted on 11 September 2025.

Under section 8 of the Public Holidays Act 1993, Wednesday 22 October 2025 has been declared as a full-day public holiday for the Numurkah & District in Moira Shire. This is a substitute public holiday for the Melbourne Cup public holiday on Tuesday 4 November.
