Domestic Animals Act 1994

All cats and dogs three months of age or older must be registered with their local council. The owners of a dog or cat who fail to register their animal may be liable for a fine up to 20 penalty units. A child's dog or cat must be registered in the parent's or guardian's name if they are under 18 years old.

Farm Working Dogs	If your dog is a farm working dog, proof of an annual tax deduction or a Statutory Declaration is required. "Farm working dog" means a dog that herds, droves, protects, tends or works stock on land used solely or primarily for primary production. "Farmer" means a person engaged in primary production whose primary source of income is from that primary production.	
Microchipping	All dogs/cats over 3 months must be microchipped prior to registration. This includes previously registered dogs and cats from another Council that are now kept within Moira Shire. Owner must supply a copy of the microchip certificate at the time of registration.	
Excess Animal Permits	Permits must be obtained to keep more than two dogs and/or two cats per residential area or commercial area, or on any property in a rural area which comprises less than eight hectares.	
Collection Statement	Moira Shire Council is collecting information on this form for municipal purposes as specified in various acts, regulations and local laws that council has a responsibility to administer. The Personal Information will be used solely by Council for these purposes and or directly related purposes. Council may disclose this information to other organisations if required by legislation.
